Background

An Environmental Consultancy was struggling with understanding their cyber risk posture and the potential threats they face:

- Rapidly growing organisation with risk increasing as they take on extra staff and larger premises.
- Difficulty tracking where all client data resided, especially with remote workers copying files locally.
- No clear vision of cyber awareness training requirements.
- Concern about the amount of sensitive data they were holding on behalf of clients in order for them to carry out the tasks they were under contract to carry out.

Solution
